Despite concerns from the Public Health and Scientific communities the Government is continuing to ease lockdown restrictions and only a few parts of the economy are still affected. Society itself has changed, and the hot weather and decision to half the 2 metre rule has led to scenes in Liverpool and on many beach resorts which have all but consigned social distancing to the dustbin.

So will there be "a second spike" in Covid-19?
